As the title suggests, this is a demolition game set, unsurprisingly, in a war-ravaged future — just as well otherwise, it'd be a case of knocking down factory chimneys or 1960s towerblocks. Your job: to clear the path for a truck carrying leaky nuclear warheads, using a roster of 15 different vehicles (futuristic bulldozers, mainly or else Transformers-style destructo-robots). Inconveniently-placed buildings must be flattened, lest the devices bump into them and "go off". That's pretty much it. Aerial view, chugging music, some girl on an intercom saying, "You're just trying to impress me!" after every level-completion, it's reasonably well-drawn, but your promotion from Rookie Wrecker to, ahem, Master Despoiler soon becomes an arduous one. ★★★ AC

How to follow the cultural frenzy that followed Tomb Raider, launching the zeitgeist-rocking Lara Croft onto magazine covers, singles, posters and the inevitable movie tie-in (Demi Moore, apparently)? Thankfully, Eidos have done more of the same — Croft running, jumping, flipping and blasting her way through 16 new levels. The storyline is similar, a lost mystical dagger the goal, but the emphasis is on variety: there are as many "modern" levels

(Venice, an oil rig, a sunken wreck) as ancient atmospheric ruined tombs. All of them designed within an inch of their lives. Gameplay has been expanded but not altered (it's as playable as ever) with lighting effects (you carry flares); a climbing facility,

wading in water, more weapons, more baddies (including many more human foes — damnation they are so tough!) and, coolest of all, vehicles (you climb in, you take control). There is also a change in feel. TR gave you breathing space, a chance to ponder puzzles, TR2 is more about thinking on your feet than on your laurels. Hence, this is a whole lot tougher than its predecessor. Regardless of all the frenetic ephemera, TR2 is everything we wanted it to be. The best possible sequel to the best bloody game in existence. ★★★★★

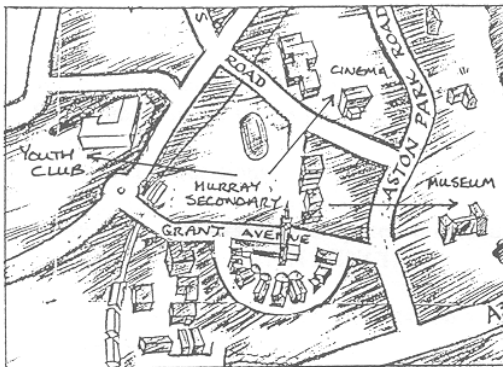

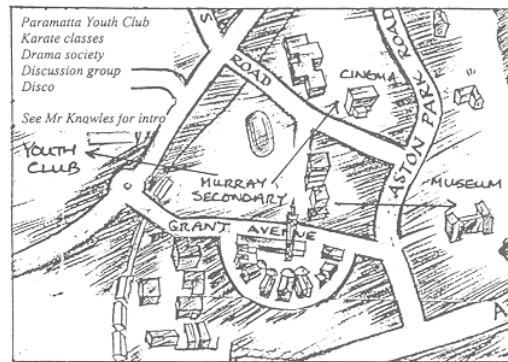

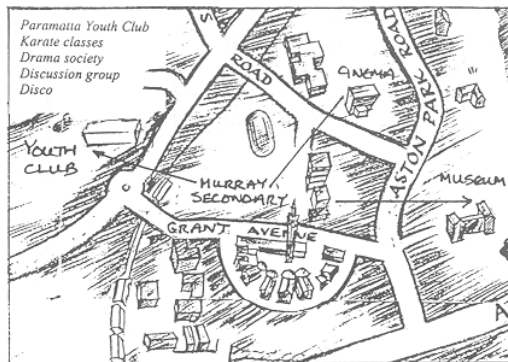
